

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE Oneida County Planning & Zoning Committee will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, February 1, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. in Committee Room #2, Oneida County Courthouse, Rhinelander, WI 54501 on the following:

Ordinance Amendment #1-2012 Section 9.78, Sign Regulations, authored by the Planning and Zoning Committee to amend Section 9.78, Sign Regulations, of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance.

On-premise signs: Only allow one free standing on-premise sign per parcel, modify the size of an on-premise sign in relation to the setback from the road, increase the size of a sign for a multi-tenant business.

Projecting Signs: New allowances for projecting signs in Business B-1, District #6.

Electronic Message Signs: Allows full spectrum color for electronic message signs except in Business B-1, District #6.

Exempted Signs: Increases the size of political signs to 32 square feet, allows a sign on personal property with no commercial content if the sign is less than 12 square feet. Allows promotional banners with conditions, allows open signs situated outside the business. Allows sandwich boards with conditions.
