

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION MEETING – MARCH 25, 2013

Members present: Tim Melms, Bruce Rhode, Bernie Dart, John Vanney and Mary Martin. Also present were: Corporation Counsel Brian Desmond, Sheriff Grady Hartman, Chief Deputy John Sweeney and Lt. Dan Hess. Present part of the meeting was Lt. Lloyd Gauthier.

The meeting was called to order at 1 p.m. by Chair John Vanney. The meeting was properly noticed in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting laws. The agenda for the March 25<sup>th</sup> meeting was approved on a motion by Melms, seconded by Rhode. All members voting “aye.” MC

Vanney stated that the commission discussed the Kibler complaint with Asst. Dist. Attorney Desmond and the sheriff’s officers present. No action was taken during the closed session.

The next meeting will be April 22, 2013 to establish an eligibility list for detective sergeants. Lt. Gauthier said there are no immediate openings for the position.

Sheriff Hartman told the Commission the proposed merging of the Emergency Management department with the Oneida County Sheriff’s office is progressing. He introduced Ken Kortenhof, emergency management director, who will become an employee of the Sheriff’s office when the merger is complete.

Also on the agenda for April 22, 2013 will be discussion concerning the entry level matrix for evaluating Oneida County deputies.

There being no further business the Commission adjourned at 2:38 p.m. on a motion by Rhode, seconded by Martin. MC
